

Housing Application Form

Citrus Research & Education Center, Lake Alfred, FL

- CREC dorm space is for UF students seeking a UF degree, post-docs and academic visitors (student and faculty). The dorms are to be used as a temporary accommodation for newly arriving residents until they can get acquainted with the area and find other housing.
- Space is assigned on a first come, first served basis. UF students have priority over other tenant categories. One room will be reserved for visiting scientists.
- Tenancy is restricted to a one-time stay of 6 months. No return stays permitted.
- Occupancy start dates are indicated below
 - January 1 for Spring Semester Housing
 - August 15 for Fall Semester Housing
- Any vacancies, open within six weeks of the general start dates will be open to post-docs and academic visitors (student and faculty).
- Monthly charge is \$250.
- Occupants have responsibility to work with other occupants of dorm to appoint a resident leader. The resident leader is expected to internally solve any issues that may arise in the dorm. If issues cannot be solved amongst occupants, they shall be reported to graduate student committee chair or housing administrator.
